Bruce Marshall 3-6-9 Doubles Tournament Rules

- 1. Any person, 18 or older, may bowl in this event. No USBC membership required.
- 2. The tournament shall be conducted on a handicap basis, being determined as 100% of the difference of the bowler's average of 230. Average will be the highest sanctioned average (of 21 games or more in any county) for the 2022-2023 season as per Bowl.com (first winter then summer). Sport and challenge averages will be converted per the USBC average conversion sheet. If a bowler does not have an established 2022-2023 average, they must use their highest 2023-2024 season average with a minimum of 21 games. The plus 10 rule is waived. Non-sanctioned bowlers: Use highest average within last 5 seasons, if not available then men use 180, and women use 150. *ALL AVERAGES WILL BE VERIFIED AT CHECK-IN*.
- 3. The doubles team may consist of any combination of genders. 2 bowlers per team and up to 3 teams per lane. Lanes assigned by the tournament director, **submit entries together to be paired together.**
- 4. Entries submitted by the closing date will ensure an entry into the tournament, space is limited. Cross-over requests are not guaranteed. If desired, please submit entries together notating the request. Walkins may be permitted if lanes are available but are not guaranteed.
- 5. Prizes will be awarded in the form of gift cards graciously donated for this event. 100% of proceeds will be going to the BVL.
- 6. In the case of a tie for first place, the tiebreaker will be the team head-to-head scores of game 1, then if needed game 2 and so on through game 4. If still tied, co-champions will be awarded.
- 7. All bowlers shall report to the tournament sign-in desk at least a half hour prior to bowling to verify averages, line-up, and receive lane assignment.
- 8. These and other rules deemed necessary by the Tournament Management shall govern.
- 9. **NOTICE TO ALL BOWLERS:** Read Rule 319e of the USBC Rule Book on the bowler's responsibility to submit averages. Your compliance with this rule is MANDATORY if you meet the requirements. Read Rule 319d. It is the bowler's responsibility to report their scores in any tournament in which they have qualified for \$300.00 or more in any event.
- 10. Prizes shall be distributed the day of the event. Any and all protests/appeals should be shared with the Tournament Director before the completion of bowling.
- 11. Please be respectful of the establishment. The tournament committee reserves the right to refuse participation to anyone deemed to be inappropriately attired or shows disrespect to the bowling center without recourse.
- 12. Only complete entry forms will be accepted. Non-sanctioned bowlers should enter average based on instructions as listed in rule #2.
